- Monthly meetings for supporting, equipping, and belonging.

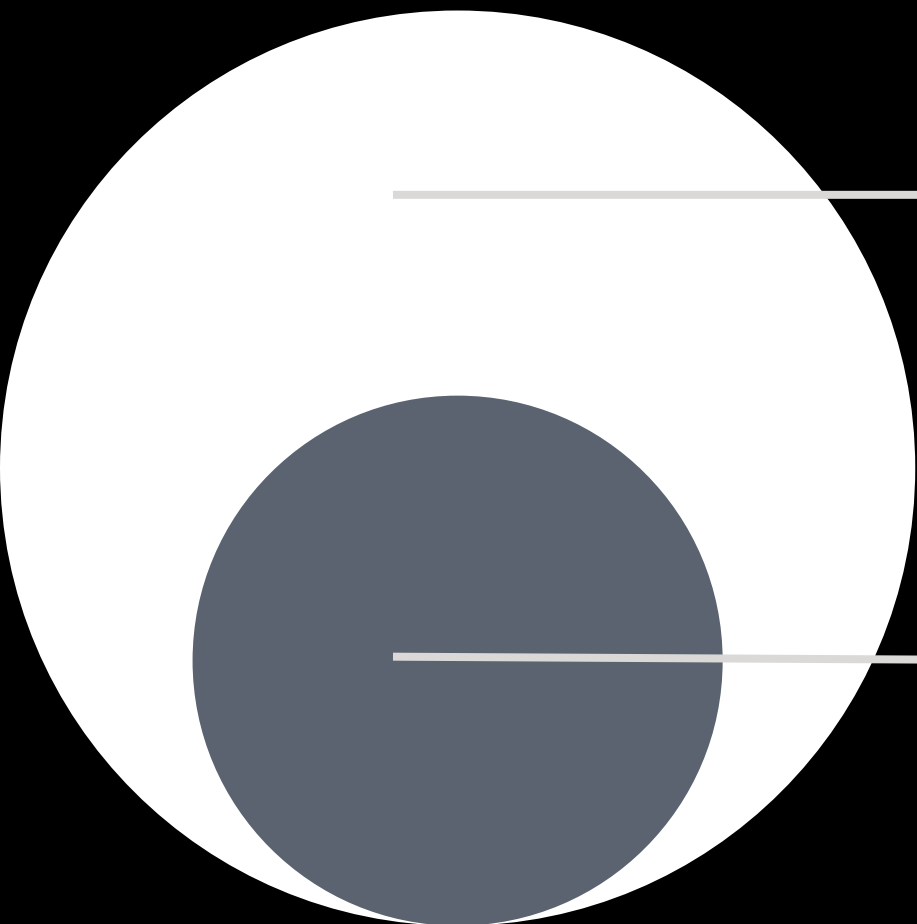
2. Rallying youth

Youth Worker Engagement

At the 306 Network, we believe in the importance of healthy point youth workers. We desire to foster this through monthly gatherings that support, equip, and create a sense of belonging.

This year, we brought in a variety of high-quality guest speakers to speak into the lives of our point youth workers and their youth ministries. We created space for conversations about leadership, youth ministry skills, and soul care. Additionally, we took many times to slow down, connect, and evaluate 'how things are really going.'

We are incredibly encouraged to hear things such as...

"I have seen in our region a drastic increase in partnerships and kingdom collaboration. The result of unity and seeking the Lord is that many youth are growing in discipleship."

"I think the 306 Network tilling the soil regionally has made the biggest difference in this impact for me. I feel so cared for regionally now. I no longer just 'go' to some event, but feel part of something."

This is why we do what we do with youth workers at the 306.



Youth Rallies

We finished off our second season of running rallies at the 306 Network, and it has truly been incredible to see our rallies stay consistently attended while growing from engaging 47 churches to 62 in one year!

We ran three rallies with a 'Scripture' emphasis, compelling youth to dive deep into the Scriptures and allowing the word of God, through the power of the Holy Spirit, to transform our students' lives as a collective region.

Here is what was said:

"I've been struggling with anxiety lately, but when we were worshipping, I felt the Holy Spirit wash over me and calm me."

"I felt that God was reminding me that He can work around me despite all my shortcomings!"

"Through these rallies I really felt more connected with God and also my community around me"

This season of doing rallies has been incredibly fruitful and seeing Him working in it all has blown us all away here at the 306.



Alpha Youth Cohort

We finished off our first year running our Alpha Youth Cohort!

We had incredible engagement, with more Alpha Youth groups starting and students in our city unifying by sharing their faith at their schools.

This year, we met three times to discuss how Alpha Youth was going and also held training sessions.

These students who ran student-led Alpha groups saw up to 70 people show up, which was incredible. Here are things captured from our students:

“Holy Cross’ first meeting went super well!! We had lots of great discussion and 53 people showed up. We are very grateful for all the support from the 306 network!!”

“God has been working through this and there are lots of people from the church who are praying for us ...

... and want to help us out! Let’s keep up the good work for God.”

“BJM is starting alpha this wednesday, we have pizza lined up and video prepped. We are somewhat nervous, no idea how many will show up.”

We are incredibly proud of our students and cannot wait to see what God has in store for them!
